Members noted the documents relating to the Three Rivers District Council validation requirements for planning applications.

PD3109/18 TRDC Proposed Car Parking Changes

Members discussed the proposed car parking changes which may affect the current conditions of the Community Way Car Park. Members had concerns over whether the new restrictions would have too detrimental impact on those residents wishing to visit the shops along New Road and the employees of the business based in the area.

The Clerk also raised concerns over what impact that the changes would have on the Barton Way allotment holders.

Resolved:

 That Croxley Green Parish Council raises a formal objection with TRDC about the planned changes to the Community Way car park. CGPC are particularly concerned that there is not a sufficiently retained amount of long-term parking bays to meet local demand. CGPC acknowledge that there is a significant problem with the car park being used by commuters using the Metropolitan Line station to the detriment of other users.

Herts CC resupplies the bins, also provides a stockpile which is at the Parish Offices (bagged)

Number of other footways (called "pavements") adjacent to roads, maintained by Herts CC

Number of other footways on private land within developments, some maintained by Herts CC, some maintained by TRDC.

If work is carried out on the Right of Way footpaths, done by Herts CC RoW contractors & refunded to the PC.

4056 Street Trees

Steve Drury (Herts CC & TRDC councillor) has some funding in locality budget but no one has come back to ther Parish Council to request trees.

S96 of the Highways Act can be used to delegate powers to PC, but not so far.

Need a programme to install and maintain street trees. PC does already maintain some replacement trees (e.g. on Dover Way)
