EA914/12 Apologies for Absence

EA918/12 Matters Arising

EA918/12 Matters Arising (EA910/12 Matters Arising; EA903/12 (Nectar/Oasis sites on third party land). It was asked if, following their meeting of 10 September, the Residents' Association had put forward any ideas for locations. The Administrative Officer replied that they had not but the locations suggested by their Chairman prior to their meeting had been sent to Julie Munro at Herts County together with locations suggested by those Parish Councillors who had submitted them.

EA919/12 Active Works List

The Chairman introduced this item and Members were referred to the active works list for November.

It was pointed out that the roses on the Two Bridges roundabout were in such a poor state it was felt that they should be removed and replaced with shrubs and this was possibly something to consider in the budget discussions.

The Chairman advised that she had already submitted a proposal for the senior citizen's seaside trip. It was pointed out that the Parish Council's precept is not capped but the current economic climate must be taken into consideration.
