Dear David

How are you? I hope you are well?

I am contacting you as Three Rivers District Council are due to upgrade Cassiobridge play area, located next to the canal by the Sea Cadets Building and the Harvester in Croxley Green.

This play area was due to be upgraded as part of the Croxley Rail Link project, however, as I am sure you are aware, this is no longer happening.

The play area is in desperate need of upgrading and is coming to the end of its life. Three Rivers District Council have agreed to upgrade this, using S106 funding and Leisure capital grant money. However, the total budget is £70,000, which would result in a very basic play area and I therefore wondered, as this play area is within Croxley Green Parish, whether or not the Parish Council would have any S106 or CIL funding they would be interested in putting

towards this scheme? We will ensure the Croxley Green Parish Council logo is on the operator signage and make reference to the Parish Council on any marketing or promotion for this. In addition, we will ensure the Parish Council are consulted on the designs submitted as part of the procurement process and involved as the project develops.

I have included the link to the committee paper where this was agreed, including the RPI annual inspection report for this play area for your reference and should you require an other information, then please do not hesitate to contact me.
