

**Croxley House 'pond' ('Pond' 1), north east corner of Croxley Green, adj Croxley House
(opposite Killingdown Farm entrance, Dugdales)**

At the time of viewing (October 2006), this pond had only a small amount of shallow, open water, with a majority of the surface covered with a range of wetland vegetation. The pond is steeply sided with short vegetation on all sides.

1. Remove no more than 1/4 (quarter) of the surface wetland vegetation, including the roots each year to create new areas of open water. The dredged material should be left at the edge of the pond for a day before disposal, to allow any wildlife to move back into the pond.
2. The tall meadow vegetation on the green should be extended up to the edge of the pond to give greater cover to wildlife.
