Dear David

How are you? I hope you are keeping well.

I am not sure if you are aware, but Croxley Green Skate Park is in our capital programme for 2018/19 to refurbish. The current proposals are to demolish the existing park and build a destination multi-wheeled facility (for skateboards, scooters and BMX). The budget is currently set at £315,000, of which the TRDC will be investing £200,000 of their capital budget and an additional £32,871 S106 funding (subject to agreement at the Leisure, Health and Wellbeing Committee on the 6<sup>th</sup> September).

This leaves a shortfall of £82,000, of which we are hoping to apply to Sport England for. However, I wondered if the Parish Council would like to be involved in the project and whether or not you had any capital funds available to invest? I am happy to come along and discuss this further if required?
