Proposed Permit Parking Scheme (CPZ) on Public Roads in Croxley Green

Introduction

This paper proposes a response to the public consultation (stage 3 consultation) on the introduction of proposed permit parking scheme (another Controlled Parking Zone, or CPZ) in Croxley Green.

Discussion

Three Rivers District Council (TRDC) has been progressing a Croxley Green Parking Review over the last couple of years. At the IHED meeting on 25 June 2019 TRDC decided, on the basis of the stage 2 informal consultation, to progress to a final scheme with the detailed design stage (Stage 3) and formal public consultation, including the Parish Council.

The proposals were discussed at the P&D committee on 4 July 2019 and a way ahead was agreed.

Peter Simons – Senior Transport Planner / Transport and Parking Projects TRDC, met Ryan Bennett and Andrew Gallagher on 23 July to discuss the proposed detailed designs.

The detailed designs (dated May 2019) were issued on 31 July 2019 and TRDC wrote to householders within the proposed permit zone, and those nearby likely to be affected by “displacement parking”, to invite their comments by 9th September. A set of the plans was deposited at the parish Council offices for inspection.

The Parish Council prepared an information leaflet that was delivered to local homes likely to be affected either by the proposed CPZ or by displacement parking to encourage residents to respond. The TRDC district councillors for Dickinsons Ward also prepared an information leaflet in a personal capacity that was delivered to local premises likely to be affected.

The Parish Council had intended to commission an independent professional review of the proposals but, in the event, this has not happened for a number of reasons.

The council’s response was discussed at the P&D on 5 September and the proposed response has been prepared in the light of those discussions

Recommendations

- The Council reviews the proposed response and approves it for transmission to TRDC subject to any agreed modifications.
